

## ROLE OF COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVES

## Council Representatives shall

- represent the interests of their Specialty groups
- attend (or ensure that their Specialty group's designated alternate representative attends) all Council meetings
- participate, or actively seek volunteers from their Specialty groups to participate, on committees or working groups that are formed during their tenure
- update their Specialty group's membership on Consultant Specialists of BC activities
- respond to Consultant Specialists of BC communications (e-mail, letters and phone calls) in a timely fashion
- keep in regular contact with the Executive (via the Consultant Specialists of BC office) for the mutual exchange of information, and
- maintain the confidentiality required on sensitive issues or privileged information that may be discussed at Council meetings, on Zoom or via email.

\*\*\* Council Representatives and their alternates must be members in good standing of the Consultant Specialists of BC to attend meetings. \*\*\*
